



<u>Annex VI:Levels and rules applicable to the calculation of grant</u> <u>amounts</u>

In 2007- Slovenia (LLP-Leonardo da Vinci Mobility)

ARTICLE III - FINANCING THE ACTION

The total grant for a project covers two main parts: the costs related to the mobility of the participant (subsistence and travel) and the costs related to the management of the project (including organisation of mobility and preparation of participants). The grants are calculated on the basis of scales of unit costs allocated as a per capita grant for outgoing mobility. The individual grants will be calculated by institutions individually according to the rules in the Call LLP 2007, Part II: Administrative and financial information (Table 5a).

The grant calculation differs from target group:

Target group :

- IVT (People undergoing initial vocational training),
- PLM (People in the labour market)

The actual **final amount** of each item shall be determined in accordance with the rules set out hereafter:

- the contribution to **subsistence**¹ costs will be determined on the basis of the number of days/weeks/months multiplied by a fixed daily/weekly/monthly amount of EUR as set by <u>Table 5a</u> on the basis of proof of travel dates.
- the contribution to **costs of pedagogical, cultural and language preparation** will be determined as a flat-rate amount on the basis of the actual number of participants;
- the contribution to the **management costs** will be determined as a flat-rate amount on the basis of the actual number of participants

Travel costs are included into subsistence costs.

Duration of mobility:

- for target group IVT (People undergoing initial vocational training) the minimum period is 2 weeks and the maximum period is 39 weeks. Duration of mobility for two weeks must include a minimum of 10 days of training programme.
- for target group PLM (People in the labour market) the minimum period is 2 weeks and the maximum period is 26 weeks. Duration of mobility for two weeks means minimum 10 days of training programme.

Maximum for **management costs**:

- o IVT (People undergoing initial vocational training) 200 €/person
- **PLM** (People in the labour market) 250 €/person

The grant for monitoring and management includes the costs for the insurance of participants.

Maximum for **preparation of participant**:

- o IVT (People undergoing initial vocational training) 300 €/person
- **PLM** (People in the labour market) 400 €/person

Target group :

• VETPRO (Professionals in Vocational Education and Training)

The actual final amount of each item shall be determined in accordance with the rules set out hereafter:

 the contribution to subsistence² costs will be determined on the basis of the number of [days/weeks/months] multiplied by a fixed [daily/weekly/monthly] amount of EUR on the basis of proof of travel dates;

The subsistence rate will be calculated according to the following rule:

- for the first week of the mobility 85% of the maximum weekly rate set in the Table 5a
- \circ for all following weeks the rates set in the table 5a apply.
- the contribution to **costs of travel**, will be determined on the basis of the real costs incurred;
- the contribution to **costs of pedagogical, cultural and language preparation** will be determined as a flat-rate amount on the basis of the actual number of participants;
- the contribution to the **management costs** will be determined on the basis of the actual number of participants

Duration of mobility:

 for target group VETPRO (Professionals in Vocational Education and Training) the minimum period is 1 week and the maximum period is 6 weeks. Duration of mobility for one week must include 5 days of training programme.

- PLM: »Young people« rates
- VETPRO:«Adult« rates

Maximum for **monitoring and management costs** - 200 €/person. The grant for monitoring and management includes the costs for the insurance of participants.

Maximum for **preparation of participants -** 200 €/person.
