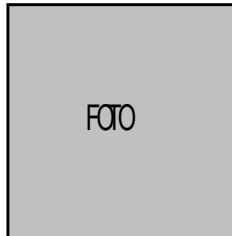

- In addition, a 1 or 2 page letter shall be attached explaining the reasons for which the applicant is interested on carrying out research in Mexico.
- Original and complete applications as well as those submitted in time will be taken into account. Applications sent by email or fax will not be taken into account.
- The General Directorate for Educational and Cultural Cooperation is responsible of purchasing and managing the international air travel; therefore, any refund may be done in case the applicant or the receiving institution purchase directly the air travel.
- If the applicant cancels his/ her trip, once the air ticket has been issued by the SRE authorized travel agency, the receiving institution or the applicant will be requested to pay the flight ticket if it is not refundable.
- If the economy class fare ticket implies a stop or connection in any USA city, the applicant shall assured the accreditation and validity of the corresponding visa

Documents which must accompany Application Form B

1. Use Application form B of this Call (*), corresponding to the year when the activity will be performed, properly filled in Spanish language, handwritten signed by the applicant and accompanied by a photograph..
2. Letter of acceptance from the receiving Mexican academic institution addressed to the General Director for Educational and Cultural Cooperation of the SRE mentioning the special program for which the scholarship is requested and clearly indicating the Lecture, Research, Professorship or Artistic Work title, according to the case, that the foreign citizen will perform as well as activity starting and ending dates.
3. If the candidature is submitted through our diplomatic or consular representation in the applicant's country of origin, the invitation letter of the Mexican institution shall be attached.
4. Resume in Spanish Language.
5. In addition, include the specific requirements of the Special Program to who will apply.
6. In the case of "Genaro Estrada" Programs for Specialist in Mexico (Mexicanists), Special Professorship, visits for mass media collaborators and artistic creation, include 8 photographs (not in digital print) if the visit last longer than two (2) months, and 2 photographs if the visit last no more than 2 months.
